

2012 Foundation for Peace Mission Trips



Mission statement: The Foundation for Peace is a 501(c)(3) not-for profit organization dedicated to working hand in hand with people in materially impoverished areas of the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica and Kenya to provide educational support, healthcare access, economic opportunity and hope. We work together as long-term partners in solidarity to enable personal success and community achievement. We believe this will result in sustainable and successful initiatives that relieve the effects of poverty, encourage personal growth, and overcome injustice.

Overview: Mission trips are multifaceted and focused on building relationships by working “hand in hand” with the local church on construction projects, free medical care and educational programs regardless of race, religion, gender. No particular physical or language skills are required for our trips. There are no age limitations, but “developing world” conditions may preclude participation by those with certain health conditions. Single and married adults, families, teenagers, and children accompanied by their parents are welcome.

Act Now: Begin planning your involvement in a trip TODAY, space is limited. Interested persons should apply online at www.foundationforpeace.org. Letters requesting prayer support and fundraising assistance should begin after completion of the online application and submission of the non-refundable deposit (\$250 for DR and Haiti trips and \$500 for Kenya). The in-country cost for summer trips to the DR is \$1,150 plus airfare and to Haiti is \$1,250 per person plus airfare. For Kenya, the cost is \$1,750 plus airfare for the scheduled trips. The in-country fee covers all trip costs plus construction supplies, medicines and educational materials. Other trips have fees based upon time and project needs.
