



Haiti: Guidelines for Church Services

DRESS

- **Men:** Wear long pants and short-sleeved collared shirts. Sandals are not acceptable. Shoes should be clean. Piercings should be taken out. Tattoos should be covered, if possible..
- **Women:** Wear skirts and blouses with sleeves over the shoulder or dresses with short sleeves. Dresses or skirts should be at least knee length. Jewelry and make-up must be kept at a minimum. Clean sandals (not flip-flops) are acceptable. Piercings in places other than ears should be taken out or very small jewelry worn. Tattoos should be covered, if possible.

BEHAVIOR

- Avoid chewing gum in church services.
- Do not cross your legs in a church service.
- Sit among the Haitians, not as a group.

ITEMS TO BRING

- Your Bible
- Water bottle
- Camera, if you wish
- Small offering, if you wish
- Flashlight to read with or in case power goes out

PREPARATION

- Have at least one song prepared by the group. Testimonies or other offerings by individuals or pairs can also be included.
- A pastor or leader with the group is welcome to preach at a service.
- A Sunday morning service in Haiti includes Sunday school and Worship.

If you have questions, ask your group leader or an FFP staff member.
